This map illustrates the isolation of Au Dis from the city of Jerusalem by the Annexation Wall. Home to 13,500 Palestinians, as well as the main campus of alQuds University, Abu Dis is today an 8-meter-high concrete wall and a checkpoint away from Jerusalem.

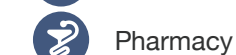

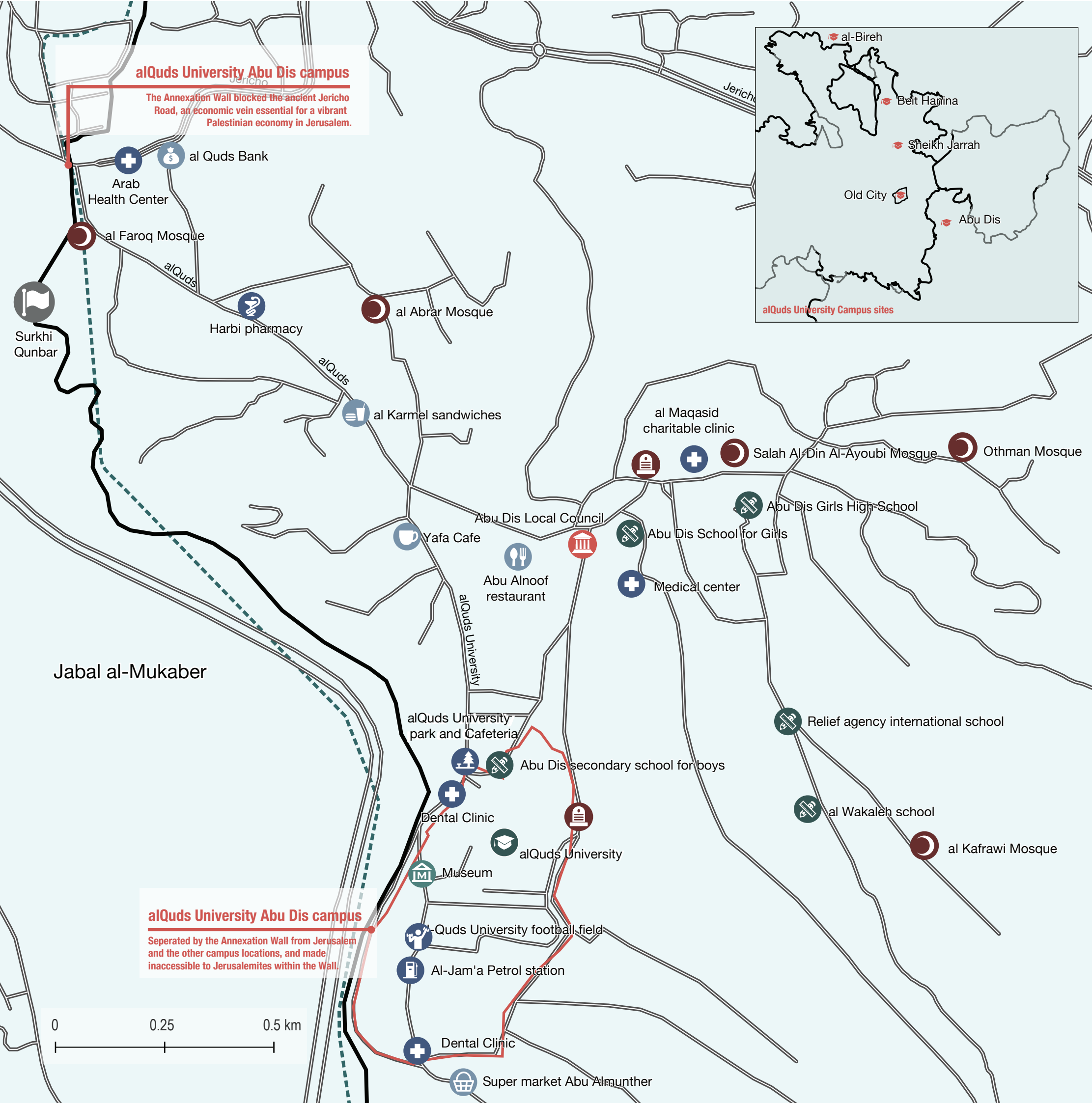
